CREDIT HOURS – TCSPP awards credit by the semester credit hour.

CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE (CGPA) – The CGPA is determined by dividing the total number of grade points earned by the total number of credit hours attempted. All grade points earned are counted on a 4.0 scale.

SATISFACTORY ACADEMIC PROGRESS (SAP) – A graduate student is considered in Academic and Financial Aid Good Standing if the student has earned a CGPA of 3.0 or higher and has successfully completed a minimum of 66.67% of all credit hours attempted. An undergraduate student is considered in Academic and Financial Aid Good Standing if the student has earned a CGPA of 2.0 or higher and has successfully completed a minimum of 66.67% of all credit hours attempted.

Academic and Financial Aid Warning: One term/semester of a CGPA below 3.0 for a graduate student and below 2.0 for an undergraduate student and/or Rate of Progress below 66.67% for all students results in this SAP status.

Academic and Financial Aid Probation: If a student is not able to academically respond to Academic and Financial Aid Warning in one term/semester, the student is placed in this SAP status.

Academic Dismissal: If a student fails to meet the conditions of the SAP Development Plan or SAP standards at the end of the Academic and Financial Aid Probation period or fails to appeal the Academic and Financial Aid Probation status, the student is academically dismissed.

TRANSFER CREDIT – Transfer credit is counted toward the number of credit hours required for degree completion. It is not factored into the calculation of the CGPA.

REPEATING A COURSE – When a course is successfully repeated, the new course grade is computed into the CGPA. The quality points for the original grade are excluded from the CGPA but are counted toward credit hours attempted, thereby affecting SAP. All final grades remain in the student's permanent record.

CAMPUS INDICATOR – A student enrolled in the online campus is indicated with an "O" after the enrollment number. An on-ground student is indicated with a "G" after the enrollment number.

TERM HONORS – Effective Fall 2014, an undergraduate student who earns a term GPA of 3.5 to 3.79 will be named to the Dean's Honor List if all conditions noted in the Academic Catalog are met. An undergraduate student who achieves a term GPA of 3.80 to 4.00 will be named to the President's Honor List if all conditions noted in the Academic Catalog are met.

DEGREE HONORS - Effective Spring 2015, an undergraduate student who earns a CGPA of 3.5 or higher at degree completion and who meets all other requirements as defined in the Academic Catalog will be recognized with Latin honors. Effective Spring 2016, a graduate student who achieves a CGPA of 4.0 at degree completion and who meets all other requirements as defined in the Academic Catalog will be recognized with degree honors.

CALIFORNIA GRADUATE INSTITUTE (CGI), DALLAS NURSING INSTITUTE (DNI), SANTA BARBARA GRADUATE INSTITUTE (SBGI) – TCSPP acts as custodian of CGI, DNI, and SBGI academic records.
